Special Events:

Demolition Derby returns to the Action Sports Arena July 5-6, with the RV Demolition Derby closing out the fun out on July 7.

The Junior Livestock Auction takes place prior to fair opening at July 7 at 9am at the Amador Pavilion.

Kids activities include Environment and Space themed STEAM activities, and Kids Pedal Tractor Pull.

Horse racing:

Horse racing continues through Sunday, July 7 at the Stella Artois Grandstand with the first post time at 1:45.

The \$50,000 Oak Tree Sprint Stakes take place July 4 and the \$100,000 Everett Nevin Stakes take place July 6.

Also at the Grandstand this year is the Encounters UFO Experience exhibit, open every day of the Fair.

Fair Favorites:

All the fair favorites continue through Sunday, including carnival rides and games, animals, exhibits, pig races, Butterfly Exhibit, fair food and much, much more.
