Vince Neil of Mötley Crüe Joins Big O Tires Concert Series Lineup at 2019 Alameda County Fair

Pleasanton, Calif. – For glam rock fans, it's a heavy metal dream come true: Vince Neil of Mötley Crüe will rock the Amphitheater on Sunday, July 7 at 8pm at the Alameda County Fair in Pleasanton.

The legendary frontman will perform Mötley Crüe's biggest hits including *Girls, Girls, Girls*, *Kickstart My Heart*, *Wild Side*, *Shout at the Devil* and *Home Sweet Home*, as well as songs from three solo albums and his newest projects.

In the meantime, fans may want to check out *The Dirt*, a just-released Netflix movie based on the band's wild rise to fame in the 1980s.

Reserved seats go on sale to the public starting Thursday, April 4 and pre-sale to Season Pass holders starting Wednesday, April 3. Ticket must be purchased through the Fair's website. Prices include Fair admission.

Seating at the Bud Light Concert Lawn area just outside the Amphitheater is always free with admission and features a live stream video of every concert on the giant Jumbotron screen.
