POSITION SCOPE:

You will work in our Equestrian Center preparing, maintaining and refurbishing for the stabling of 600 racehorses. This seasonal full time position assists with general labor and custodial maintenance in our Equestrian Center and runs from April through August supporting our Live Horse Race Meet.

- Minor repairs
- Ground Maintenance (mowing, blowing, weeding, etc.)
- Monitoring Tenants on water control standards
- Building Maintenance
- Cleaning horse stalls
- All other duties as assigned
