### **Drone Show Added to Three Movie Nights**

Pleasanton, Calif. – December at the Fairgrounds is full of festive events for the entire family.

A Drone Show has been added to the last three Drive-In Movies this month. The winter-themed Drone Show will play above the movie screen in the middle of the lot. The three movies are Nightmare Before Christmas, Frozen, and Abominable. The Drone Show will start at 6pm, immediately before the movie.

In addition, the team at the Fairgrounds built four 50 foot lighted Christmas tree structures for the community to enjoy and add some holiday cheer. The lights are visible from Bernal Avenue and while at the Drive-In Movies.

Nuhua Pizza, Nahua Mexican, Hol N Jam, and a Holiday Bar will be offering food and beverages for sale at each movie. Plus popular movie treats will be available to purchase on site. All movies are rated PG and will play on a big screen in the center of the lot. Parking spaces are on sale for \$35 per vehicle and may be purchased digitally ahead or at the Gate while supplies last. Black Friday is over, but savings continue. The 2023 Fair, June 16-July 9, tickets are discounted through June 15, 2023; \$15 for general admission, \$13 for child and senior admission. General parking is \$13, one-day carnival wristbands \$32, and season passes start at \$45. Plus all December, ticket fees will be paid by the Fair. The lot is open daily from 9am to 8pm until December 21 and parking is free for all tree shoppers.
