Alameda County Fairgrounds August and September Events

Pleasanton, Calif. - Goodguys 36th West Coast Nationals returns to the Alameda County Fairgrounds August 25-27, 2023. The event will feature over 3,000 of the country's finest hot rods, trucks, customs, muscle cars, and classics. General admission is \$25, children 7-12 is \$10, children 6 and under are free.

The 157th Scottish Highland Gathering and Games returns Labor Day Weekend, September 2-3. Events include heavy athletics, highland dancing, Scottish food, and more. Ticket prices are available for single day or both days and range from \$35 to \$60. Guests may also purchase tickets to a Trackside Terrace luncheon to dine while watching the opening ceremonies from a balcony as well as a Whisky Tasting event. Tickets are all sold online only.

USA Weightlifting comes to the Alameda County Fairgrounds September 14-17 for the American Open Series. Guests may watch or enter into the weightlifting competitions. Admission is \$15 for all who attend.

A new show comes to the Fairgrounds, NorCal Corgi Con. The annual event moves to the Alameda County Fairgrounds on September 16. The one day event is the largest Corgi event in Northern California celebrating all things Corgi. Guests may enter their dog in costume, Corgi Ninja Warrior, and Mickey's Derby also known as a Corgi Race, contests. Adult Admission is \$10 and Children 7-12 is \$5. Dogs must be registered before attending and their admission is free.

The Pleasanton Wedding Show returns Sunday, September 24. This one stop shop will include wedding professionals, fashion shows, demos, and more to help prepare for the brides and grooms for their big day. Admission starts at \$15.
