POSITION: Audio Technician

Position Summary:

The Audio Technician will work with the IT Specialist and other departments as needed. This part-time position responsible for sound set-up, testing, operating and break-down of sound equipment for the Alameda County Fair and Fairgrounds.

Responsibilities:

- Prepare and operate sound equipment
- Set-up and break down of audio equipment
- Running audio equipment and checking that everything is properly connected
- Testing audio equipment for volume, tone, and clarity
- Evaluating audio equipment for repair and maintenance
- Operating mixing consoles and adjusting sounds and volumes when necessary
- Ensuring customers are happy with the sound quality and the set-up of the audio equipment
- Recommending equipment and software upgrades when necessary
- Collaborating with other Audio Technicians

Audio Technician Requirements:

- Working knowledge of Audio Architect 3.5 or later
- Working knowledge of sound mixing programs similar to Audacity
- An associate's or bachelor's degree in a field related to sound technologies.
- A minimum of 1 year of experience in an audio management role.
- Advanced knowledge of sound and recording equipment.
- Excellent communication and customer service skills.
- Good multi-tasking skills.
- Excellent computer skills.
- A strong ear for sound variants.
- A technical aptitude.
