



Welcome to the Alameda County Fair! To ensure a safe, comfortable and enjoyable experience for all attendees, we ask that guests adhere to the following Rules of Conduct

**Fairgrounds Rules of Conduct:**

- All guests must conduct themselves in a respectful manner that promotes a positive environment for everyone. Harassment, discrimination, or threatening behavior of any kind—including based on race, gender, sexual orientation, disability, religion or any protected class—will not be tolerated.
- Disruptive, disorderly, or unsafe behavior—including fighting, taunting, throwing objects or using abusive, offensive or obscene language or gestures—may result in immediate removal.
- Any act defined as a crime under federal, state or local law—including vandalism, theft or destruction of property—may be prosecuted.
- Guests must follow all instructions from event staff regarding operations and emergency procedures.
- Shoes and shirts must be worn at all times. Littering, spitting, placing feet on tabletops, or damaging property and landscaping is prohibited.
- Smoking, including e-cigarettes and vaporizers, is only permitted in designated areas. The use of marijuana products in any form is prohibited on Fairgrounds property.
- Weapons, dangerous items, alcoholic beverages, narcotics or illegal substances are not permitted. Guests showing signs of intoxication or impairment may be denied entry or removed. Security screenings are conducted at entrance gates.
- Bicycles, skateboards, Segways, mopeds, skates and rollerblades are not permitted. Drones or any unmanned aerial systems are prohibited on or above Fairgrounds property.
- No pets are permitted. Only service animals are allowed and must remain under control at all times. Service animals must be trained to perform a specific task and be harnessed, leashed or tethered unless such devices interfere with their work.
- The following items are not permitted: outside food and beverages (except for medical or dietary needs), glass containers, oversized bags or backpacks, coolers, fireworks, laser pointers, beach balls, noise-making devices, or any item deemed unsafe by management.
- Blocking or obstructing buildings, exhibits, concession areas, performance spaces, ticket windows, gates, stages, doorways, fire exits, stairways, or walkways is prohibited.
- Unauthorized solicitation, selling, or distribution of materials is not allowed. Sales may only occur in designated areas with approval from the Fair Events Department.
- Photography & Media: By entering the Fairgrounds, guests consent to being photographed, filmed, or recorded for promotional or commercial use without compensation.

- Violation of this Code of Conduct may result in removal without refund. The Fair reserves the right to deny entry or remove any individual who fails to comply or whose behavior is deemed unsafe or inappropriate, at the sole discretion of management.
