Knowledge of framing, sheetrock, general construction methods and practices followed in the maintenance of tools, machinery, and equipment; safety precautions to be observed.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

- Must possess Carpentry knowledge including; erecting, installing and finishing walls; installing doors and door frames, windows and window frames; various types of framing of floors, fences, shelving, tables, benches, cabinets, countertops, facings, signs, using woods, plastics, laminate and sheetrock.
- Competent in installing trim and other finish work
- Construction and repair projects that include metal framing, wood and finishing carpentry
- Experience using equipment and tools properly and safely, both hand tools and power tools
- Ability to understand, follow and transmit written and oral instructions
- Flexibility to work a varying schedule including some weekends and nights
- Capability to work independently or with a team
- Ability to communicate orally and in writing with co-workers
- A professional attitude and willingness to work as part of a team
- Ability to stand for long periods of time (70% of the work day)
- Use hands to handle, control, or grasp objects, tools, or controls
- Kneel, squat, crawl, twist and reach frequently during work shift (25% of the work day)

- Ability to lift 256 lbs. from waist to shoulder height
- Ability to routinely move equipment/supplies weighing up to 50 lbs. for various needs
- Must have a valid CDL and a driving record acceptable to our insurance provider

- Minimum of two (2) years carpentry experience, residential and/or commercial
